#9 Viognier 9.00

Once very rare because of the limited acreage planted throughout the world, its low yield and susceptibility to vineyard diseases made Viognier wines extremely difficult to find. The varietal gained its distinguished reputation from the northern Rhone wines of Chateau-Grillet and Condrieu. Now the grape is grown the world over, not just France, but California, Washington, Australia, Italy, Spain, South Africa and South America. The varietal is an intense dry wine with vibrant floral qualities and a bouquet reminiscent of apricot, peaches, and pears.

#10 Pinot Noir 11.00

Pinot Noir is usually light to medium-bodied with floral aromas and delicate fruit flavors. With proper growing conditions this grape makes some of the most elegant wines in the world.

#11 So, you wanna be a "Pape Star" 11.25

Chateauneuf-du-Pape, one of the world's important appellations, surrounds the village of Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Its name means "new castle of the pope," and refers to the summer palace built in the 1300s and used by the popes from Avignon. In 1923, Châteauneuf-du-Pape was the first area to adapt strict rules for grape growing and winemaking, these rules became the basis for France's national system. Thirteen varieties of grapes are permitted in the making of both red and white wines, but the main varietals for making red wine are grenache, syrah, and mourvèdre. Blends of these varietals also widely occur in both California and Australia. Expect, big, rich and full-bodied with flavors of spice and raspberry.

Okay, here is the short of it: Syrah is Shiraz, and Shiraz is Syrah, but neither are Petite Sirah, an unrelated grape. These wines are going to be highly aromatic and deeply colored showing lush fruit forward and complex flavors.

One of the five major varieties of Bordeaux, Malbec serves a role as a blending varietal, but in Argentina, Malbec is King. Full to medium bodied, rich in tannins with dried fruit, black currants and plum flavors, and a nose of cedar, smoke cassis and black cherry. Malbec pairs well with grilled steaks, or any braised, barbequed, or roasted meat.

#17 Wines from the Boot (Italy) 11.50

Italy is the world's largest producer of wine. They have been producing wine for more than 3,000 years. The three main wine regions in Italy are Piedmont, Tuscany and Veneto. In Tuscany, the major red-grape variety is Sangiovese which is used to produce Chianti. In Piedmont, the main varietal is Nebbiolo, which is used to produce some of Italy's big "heavyweight" wines such as Barolo. In Veneto, the Corvina grape is the primary grape used to produce full-bodied red wines such as Amarone.

Spain has more land dedicated to vines than any other country. The main red grape varieties grown in Spain are Tempranillo and Garnacha. It is actually only a five hour drive from Rioja, Spain to Bordeaux, France so it is no coincidence that Rioja wines often have a Bordeaux style.

CHAMPAGNE and SPARKLING

Champagne is more than just a sparkling bubbly that is enjoyed on New Year's Eve. It is France's northernmost wine making region, an hour and a half northwest of Paris. Three grapes can be used to produce true Champagne: Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay. Champagne is made by a process called Méthode Champenoise. This expression is used only in Champagne, France, outside this area it is called Méthode Traditionnelle or Classic Method.

BLUSH

Good quality rose wines are produced by allowing red grape skins to remain in limited contact with the grape juice before fermentation starts, creating a pink-tinted juice. The skins are then extracted, and the pink juice is treated in the same manner as white juice. The most common grape used is the Zinfandel grape, producing white zinfandel. Other varietals used are Syrah, Merlot and Grenache.

WHITE

RIESLING and GEWÜRZTRAMINER

Riesling can range from steely dry to toffee sweet. Wines made from Riesling are usually of a light to medium-body, with apple, pear, grapefruit and floral aromas. Gewürztraminer can yield magnificent wines, ranging from dry to off-dry to sweet. This grape produces very aromatic wines, offering scents of rose, clove, apricot, peach and candied fruit.

In Tuscany, the major red-grape variety is Sangiovese which is used to produce Chianti. In Piedmont, the main varietal is Nebbiolo, which is used to produce some of Italy's big "heavyweight" wines such as Barolo. In Veneto, the Corvina grape is the primary grape used to produce full-bodied red wines such as Amarone.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

As a grape, Cabernet Sauvignon is very small, with one of the highest ratios of skin to juice. It is a grape with medium to high acidity, with intense black currant aromas and flavors, which can be masked by high levels of tannin. Look for a medium to full-bodied wine with very smooth tannins and a long lasting finish.
