SPARKLING

Champagne is more than just a sparkling bubbly that is enjoyed on New Year's Eve. It is France's northernmost wine making region, an hour and a half northwest of Paris. Three grapes can be used to produce true Champagne: Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay. Champagne is made by a process called Méthode Champenoise. This expression is used only in Champagne, France, outside this area it is called Méthode Traditionnelle or Classic Method.

ROSE / BLUSH

Good quality rose wines are produced by allowing red grape skins to remain in limited contact with the grape juice before fermentation starts, creating a pink-tinted juice. The skins are then extracted, and the pink juice is treated in the same manner as white juice. The most common grape used is the Zinfandel grape, producing white zinfandel. Other varietals used are Syrah, Merlot and Grenache.

PINOT GRIGIO / PINOT GRIS

Similar to Syrah & Shiraz, Pinot Grigio is Pinot Gris and vice versa. Pinot Gris usually has a style that has spice and honey fruit notes such as pear and apple. They are often smooth, full-bodied wines with fresh rich aromas and marked acidity that can age beautifully. Pinot Grigio often has a scent of pineapple and spice aroma, that is followed by a very dry yet medium bodied taste.

In Tuscany, the major red-grape variety is Sangiovese which is used to produce Chianti. In Piedmont, the main varietal is Nebbiolo, which is used to produce some of Italy's big "heavyweight" wines such as Barolo. In Veneto, the Corvina grape is the primary grape used to produce full-bodied red wines such as Amarone.
